



## Fraudulent Email Alert – April 17, 2008

- On Thursday, April 17, 2008, Community Schools Credit Union began receiving calls from individuals regarding the below email. If you have received this email, please **delete it**. This is a common scam known as “phishing” where they are looking to obtain your personal information. The phone number in the email is also FAKE. If you call the number they will ask for your debit card number and expiration date. **STOP AND DON'T PROCEED ANY FURTHER WITH THIS EMAIL!**
